


# ...According to John

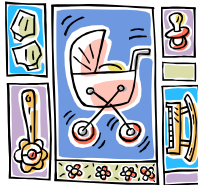

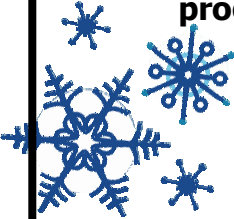


## CACS Warmth Project Still Needs Stuff!

It is now official; the Chi Rho and CYF groups have split. If it has been a while since you've come to youth group here is what happens on SUNDAYS.

For CHI RHO (grades 6-8) there is Sunday School at 9am with Brian and Becky Meyer in the youth room for now. They are discussing faith as a journey with lots of opportunity for you to talk about what you think, and share stories about yourself. Then at 3:30pm we have youth group in the youth room where we have an object lesson or active learning, big words meaning you'll have fun while you learn. Last week we talked about insults and things that hurt us emotionally and how we can build each other up. I know you have built people up this week, tell someone about it. At 4:45 you meet up with the CYF in youth choir so Randy can teach you a song. Youth choir is followed by dinner provided by a parent of the youth group.

In these shows we will discuss the various themes and how they relate to us on our faith journey.
