**WANTED!!!**

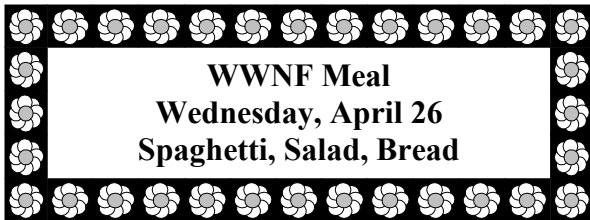

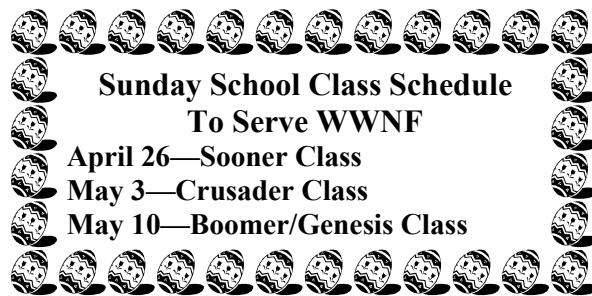
