The responsibility of the Christian Education Committee is to provide opportunities for all Central members (children, youth and adults) to discover and discuss the Christian faith. They work closely with the Director of Children's and Educational Ministries and the Minister to Youth and Young Adults. Responsibilities include: recruiting and training of Sunday school teachers for children and youth; organizing and meeting with the children and youth parent groups; organizing Vacation Bible School and Kids Time (during worship). Other responsibilities include: Senior Breakfast, Halloween Howl, Easter Egg Hunt, Children's Christmas program, Youth Mission Trips, and Church Camp.
