It's odd, but true: we have been saying "farewell" to each other since the moment we began minis- bered well at their passing. tering together in September 2022. The relationship between a Transitional Minister and a congregation begins with the acknowledgment that there is an end in view. That end point will come April 18 as we worship together for the final time.

During this time we have been brave enough to form solid connections, based on our mutual love of Christ and his church. I say "brave," because it takes a degree of faith and trust to be church together. And it took guts to welcome this stranger into your lives: We have **celebrated** – baptisms, graduations, birthdays and anniversaries, Central's 130th Anniversary, two Christmases, two Easters.

We have given thanks together – for dedicated leadership, faithful teachers, spiritual leaders, and hands that serve. For each Sunday at the Lord's Table, for stirring music, and for loved ones remem-

We have had times requiring forgiveness and the making of amends – for misunderstandings, for words spoken hastily or not soon enough, for missteps and miscalculations that sometimes arise in the context of important and difficult work.

The journey through New Beginnings continues, but there is a more focused understanding of Central's resources (people, building, finances). There is also a growing awareness that Central's "why" can't be simply "to survive" or "to maintain the status quo." Central's "why," its passion, must emerge from this: loving God, loving neighbor, and making disciples.

Finally, as we prepare to part, it is

appropriate to offer challenges to each other: to prepare your hearts to receive your next minister and my heart for my next congregation; to nurture the seeds we have planted together with hope and courageous action; and to joyfully anticipate the harvest of blessings to come.

Be kind to one another. Celebrate your successes. Look to the future, while honoring the past. And do everything for the glory of God.


